James Suckling, the American wine critic made an extensive tasting list of Spanish wines in blind tastings together with his team last month July 2018, in North of Spain more than 2,500 wines were valued.

Suckling presents his article of Spanish wines with great admiration, for its quality and its identification with the terroir.

The critic highlights the **Borsao wines for being charming and with character, full of fruit and balance, with soft, dry tannins and very pleasant acidity.**

Borsao Garnacha 2017 Campo de Borja

Proof that garnacha can give a fruity and charming wine. Juicy and slightly sweet, but with a fresh, dry finish that says barbecue!

Borsao Bole 2015 Campo de Borja

The ripe black fruit and smoke are beautifully intertwined on the nose. Quite fleshy with generous, moderately dry tannins on the palate, the crisp acidity lifting it at the finish.

Borsao Berola 2015 Campo de Borja

Light and crisp, but also full of character with some nice red-cherry aromas that pull you back for more and with each sip, the wine seems to expand a bit more.

Borsao Zarihs 2015 Syrah Campo de Borja

This has nice freshness, energy and a healthy dose of moderately dry tannins on the palate, nicely complimented by the meaty and smoky notes.

Borsao Tres Picos 2016 Garnacha Campo de Borja

More delicate and floral than many garnachas from this area with a great balance on the palate between delicately sweet fruit, fresh dry tannins and crisp acidity.
A lot of energy and excitement on the long finish
